Ms Katrina Hodgkinson to the Minister for Roads, and Minister for Western Sydney—

1. Is the NSW government providing any funding to the Upper Lachlan Shire Council to replace the 130-year-old timber bridge at Collector with a low level concrete causeway?
2. Is the existing bridge considered to have any historical or heritage value?
3. What is the assessed cost of repairing the existing bridge?
4. What is the assessed cost of demolishing this bridge and replacing it with a concrete low-level causeway?
5. Has a heritage assessment of the Collector Creek Bridge been undertaken?
